THE SOCIETY AIMS

1. To bring together in one worldwide body, collectors who, in one way or another, collect the Commonwealth stamps issued during the period of King George VI.
2. To foster and encourage the study of these stamps and their usage.
3. To provide a forum for the discussion and investigations of problems arising from the production and usage of these stamps
4. To record everything possible about the stamps of the reign, thus making available for future generations of collectors, the knowledge acquired by their predecessors
5. To urge **ADVANCED COLLECTORS** to share their knowledge, **MEDIUM COLLECTORS** to increase their knowledge and **BEGINNERS** to acquire knowledge
6. To encourage students of the stamps of the reign to collaborate with others, by correspondence or personal contact, and thus to advance their studies by sharing knowledge and the material needed for study work.

IN PURSUIT OF THESE AIMS THE SOCIETY -

PUBLISHES **GEOSIX** quarterly (March, June September and December) and Study Papers,
PROVIDES Advertisement of "Wants" and "Offers" in '**GEOSIX**' and an archival service.
HOLDS An Annual General Meeting and Auction and two Display Meetings each year at the
 Union Jack Club, London. Occasional meetings are held elsewhere in the UK.

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION £12 ('GEOSIX' by surface mail) or £16 ('GEOSIX' by airmail).

Please note that as bank charges are so very high, subscriptions from **outside the United Kingdom** should be paid in Sterling, either by an international Money order, a Sterling Draft or a cheque drawn on a UK bank account. If this is not possible, then the equivalent of £3 should be added to any non-sterling payment. Sterling or US dollar currency notes are acceptable in lieu, as are advance subscriptions.
